The Bridging Course is for those who have previously undertaken training and would prefer to use a more integrated framework going forward.

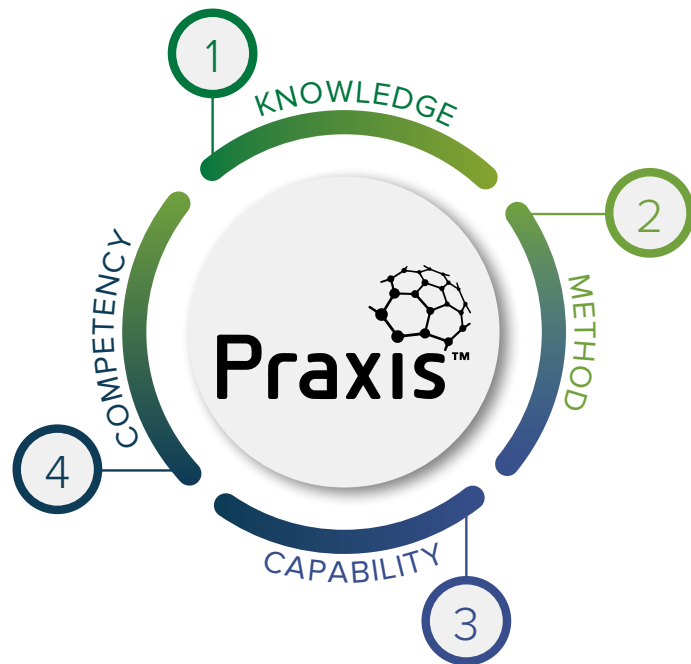
