




Apprenticeship myths debunked


 **Apprenticeships are for those who don't do well at school.**

-  Apprenticeships are simply an alternative route into skilled employment.
-  Some tech employers prefer apprenticeships as the industry evolves quickly.

 **Apprentices don't earn very much money.**

-  Apprenticeships pay at the very least the apprenticeship minimum wage (£6.40 per hour for 16–18-year olds; and those aged 19 or over and in their first year; and £11.44 per hour for those aged 19 or over and have completed their first year).
-  QAs apprenticeship vacancies pay on average between £14,000 and £18,000, with some starting as high as £18,000 to £25,000 and are often increased after the first year of training.
-  The average size of student debt post degree is £18,000 to £20,000 in Scotland.

An apprenticeship is a modern, hands-on way to train for an exciting new career in tech.



It's a paid full-time job – the apprentice will work with an employer, have a line manager, take home a salary at the end of the month and have access to employee benefits.



They'll have a structured training programme with QA, an industry recognised qualification, a personal tutor and a dedicated team member through every step in the process from application to job offer and first day at work.





Apprenticeship training designed around you



Our award-winning approach to training is based on the principles of Discover, Practice, Apply, a flexible three step process which enables every apprentice to learn at their own pace, in their own time, with individual support every step of the way.



Your child is assigned a dedicated skills coach with hourly one to one sessions every six weeks. Coaching and guidance sessions for course topics are delivered by expert tutors and your child has access to all the online learning needed to complete their apprenticeship training on time.



In addition, the digital learning team offer instant learning support and respond to 75% of queries within a minute, via online chat.

Feedback on assignments and submissions is timely and there are regular check-ins to ensure all is well.



As a result, QA apprentices are more engaged, gain skills quicker and 97% of all learners complete their training on time, or ahead of time.

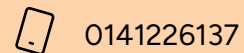
